



**In order to safeguard our schooling community's health, please take note of these additional steps we are taking in accordance with the SOPs issued by the Ministry of Health and Education respectively:**

### **We are implementing physical distancing measures**



1. We will segregate learning areas to minimize physical contact for our students.
2. School will be set up to maintain physical distancing between students. Students will be reminded to remain in their designated seating areas that are clearly outlined and marked during school hours
3. Food will be served in classrooms instead of in the common area
4. Extracurricular activities run by external vendors will be halted until further notice
5. Activities requiring physical contact and gatherings will be halted:
  - There will be no field trips, sports day and end of year concert this year as advised by the MOE/ MOH
  - Activities such as forming trains to go to bathrooms will be stopped. Children will go to the bathroom individually, with supervision from our caretakers to ensure proper hygiene practices are carried out

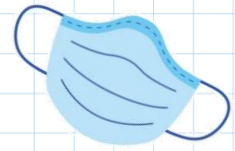
### **We have enhanced our hygiene and sanitization practices**

1. In addition to our standard practices, we have purchased additional sanitization equipment for daily use:
  - Disinfection fog machine to be used in all rooms
  - Handheld disinfectant sprayer to treat all learning materialsSanitization liquid used is non-toxic/ FDA (US)/ SIRIM approved
2. A set of utensils (bowl, plate, fork and spoon) will be allocated to each child and will not be shared. Each set will be labelled with your child's name
3. Increased frequency of handwashing, cleaning bathrooms and high touch areas such as switches and door knobs
4. Paper towels will be provided for students to dry hands



## We are using Personal Protective Equipment in school

1. All staff will be equipped with facemasks and face shields
2. While it is not compulsory for students to wear masks to school, we encourage parents to provide students a mask or face shield to wear in school. We will do our best to ensure s/he keeps the mask/shield on in school



## School visits by parents/and guardians will only be allowed if absolutely necessary

1. Parents and guardians are not allowed into classrooms for any reason including birthday celebrations
2. In the event that you need to speak to the principal, kindly give us a call, send us a message or arrange for a virtual meeting

## Students are not allowed to bring personal belongings to school

The MOE has advised that students are not allowed to bring belongings from home including school bags, food and beverages. We request parents to prepare the following CLEARLY LABELLED to be kept in school:

1. Water bottle
2. Spare uniform in a plastic bag
3. School bag to store personal belongings in school
4. Optional:
  - a. Pencil case with 3 pencils, eraser and ruler
  - b. Colouring pencils (12 colours)
  - c. Utensil set – bowl, plate, fork and spoon.
  - d. Hand towel
  - e. Face mask



To request for an exception, kindly fill up the relevant section in our SOP acknowledgement form. Daycare parents, please note that you are still required to prepare a bath towel and spare clothes for your child daily.

## All parents are required to fill up a family health declaration form and acknowledgement of SOPs on/br before 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 before students are allowed to attend school
